Satisfactory Academic and Student Progress Policy

A student is considered to be in good academic standing if s/he earns a 2.0 GPA or higher each term.

Unsatisfactory Academic Progress descriptions and requirements are as follows:

- 1. **Academic Alert**—When a certificate or degree seeking student earns below a 2.0 GPA, s/he is placed on academic alert. There is no appeal process to this level of intervention.
- 2. **Academic Warning**—When a certificate or degree-seeking student earns below a 2.0 term GPA for two consecutive terms, s/he is placed on academic warning. Once on academic warning, the student cannot change to a non-degree seeking status until s/he reaches good academic standing again.
- 3. **Academic Probation**—When a student earns less than a 2.0 GPA for three consecutive terms, s/he is placed on academic probation. The status of a student placed on academic probation will be noted on her/his transcript.
- 4. **Academic Suspension**—When a student earns below a 2.0 term GPA for four consecutive terms, s/he will be notified that s/he is suspended from the institution for one year. A notation of suspension will be placed on the students' transcript.
