The following general job descriptions relate to each of the above levels:

Level I: The student performs general tasks of a routine nature. Assignments are standard, limited and of average difficulty. The student is under close supervision at all times.

Level II: The student performs varied tasks of a specialized nature. Assignments are often complex and of a more than average difficulty. Supervision and assistance is available with a minimum of directions.

Level III: The student performs specific tasks of a technical nature. Assignments require special skills or technical training or expertise. Supervision and assistance is available with minimum supervision.
