

Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer—Elementary Education | 90+ Credits

The Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer – Elementary Education degree offers a streamlined path for CGCC students to gain credits and transfer seamlessly to any Oregon public university in pursuit of a bachelor’s degree in Elementary Education. This map is beneficial for students who know they want to transfer in Elementary Education, but who may be unsure of their intended transfer destination. CGCC’s program aligns with Eastern Oregon University, Oregon State University, Southern Oregon University, University of Oregon, and Western Oregon University. Students should work with their advisor to choose the best path for their goals, and to ensure they fulfill the requirements of this major transfer map.
