Associate of Science Transfer—Business | 90+ Credits

The Associate of Science Transfer – Business degree offers a streamlined path for CGCC students to gain credits and transfer seamlessly to an Oregon university in pursuit of a Bachelor of Science in Business. This map is beneficial for students who know they want to transfer in Business, but who may be unsure of their intended transfer destination. CGCC's program aligns with transfer requirements at Eastern Oregon University, Portland State University, Southern Oregon University and the Oregon Institute of Technology. Students should work with their advisor to choose the best path for their goals, and to ensure they fulfill the requirements of this major transfer map.
