RE-ENTRY INTO CGCC NURSING PROGRAM

The Re-Entry application is used if you were previously admitted into the Nursing program at Columbia Gorge Community College and did not successfully complete the requirements to continue. If you were unsuccessful in the first term of the program, you must re-apply for admission using the standard Nursing Application Packet. If you were unsuccessful in the 2nd to 6th term of the program, you may apply for re-entry into the program. Application for re-entry must occur within one (1) year of the last successful term in the Nursing program. In the event there is no space available in the term you are applying for re-entry, you may appeal to waive the one (1) year for re-entry for up to two (2) years from the term you were unsuccessful. Final decision regarding a waiver will be made by the Nursing Admissions Committee.

The following steps need to be completed in order to re-enter the nursing program:

1. Apply for re-admission by the specified deadline by completing the Re-Entry Application. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
2. The required prerequisite science series (A&P 1, 2, 3 - 12 credits), must have been completed with a grade of C or better with the last course of the series being completed within the last seven (7) years.
 - a. Students whose science courses were taken prior to this time may appeal for evaluation and possible waiver of the time limit requirement.
3. Successful completion of Independent Study is required for re-admission.
4. Successful completion of dropped or failed courses is required to continue in the program.
5. You are responsible for reviewing prerequisite and graduation requirements. Consult the CGCC Nursing website cgcc.edu/nursing-AAS and/or contact an Advisor in Student Services at studentservices@cgcc.edu or 541-506-6011 option 2.
6. Upon successful completion of the repeated courses and Independent Study, if there is room to re-admit the next term, you are required to obtain a new background check, drug/alcohol screen and provide updated proof of immunizations, current CPR competency, and health insurance.
7. You will be notified by email concerning your status for readmission. Readmission will not be confirmed until an opening is available.

Multiple applicants for re-admission will be ranked by the following criteria:

- GPA of nursing courses
- HSRT Test for tie-breakers

Applicants for re-admission will be accepted in the following order:

1. CGCC OCNE students in good standing;
2. Transfer from other OCNE schools in good standing
3. Returning CGCC OCNE students in poor standing
4. Transfer from non-OCNE schools in good standing

I have read and understand the above information and take responsibility for submitting my application on time and will attend all required meetings and orientations once accepted for re-entry in order to save my offered place in the program.
